

## CHAPTER 2

### ZONING DISTRICT REGULATIONS

#### SECTION:

10-2-1: Zoning Districts - General

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#### **10-2-1: ZONING DISTRICTS-GENERAL :**

A. For the purpose of this Title, the Village as shown on the Zoning Map is divided into ten (10) categories of zoning as follows:

SR-1 Single-Family Residence District

SR-2 Single-Family Residence District

SR-3 Single-Family Residence District

TR-1 Single-Family Residence District

MR-1 Two and Three-Family Residence District

MR-2 Multiple-Family Residence District

B-1 Community Business District

B-2 General Business District

B-3 Highway Business District

I-1 Industrial District

B. Whenever reference by letter designation is hereinafter made to any of the foregoing districts, such reference shall mean and include all of those districts whose symbols include such a letter used in the reference (i.e., "R" Districts include the first through the fifth of the aforesaid districts of (A) above), unless otherwise indicated in the reference. Whenever reference by word designation is hereinafter made to any of the foregoing districts, such reference shall mean and include those districts whose names include such words used in the reference (i.e., "Residence" Districts means and includes the first through fifth of the aforesaid districts of (A) above), unless otherwise indicated in the reference. (Ord. 776, 5/12/1971)

**10-2-2: ESTABLISHMENT OF ZONING DISTRICTS; BOUNDARIES:** The boundaries of the zones provided in Section 10-2-1 are established as shown on the Village Zoning District Map. The zoning districts and boundaries are hereby adopted and established as shown on the district map, which map together with all notations, references, data, district boundaries and other information thereon, are attached hereto and made a part of this Title, as well as the Zoning Ordinance by reference. The Zoning Map properly attested shall remain on file in the office of the zoning official or other appropriate Village official. (Ord. 822; 12/18/1973)

### 10-2-3: INTERPRETATION:

A. Interpretation of Provisions. In their interpretation and application, the provisions of this Title shall be held to be minimum requirements. Whenever this Title imposes a greater restriction than is imposed and required by other provisions of law or by other rules or regulations or resolutions, the provisions of this Title shall govern.

#### B. Interpretation of District Boundaries.

1. Where district boundaries are so indicated that they are approximately parallel to the center lines or street lines of streets, the center lines or alley lines of alleys, or the center lines or right-of-way lines of highways, such district boundaries shall be construed as being parallel thereto and at such district therefrom as indicated on the Zoning Map.

If no district is given, such dimensions shall be determined by the use of such scale as may be shown on said Zoning Map.

2. Where district boundaries are indicated as approximately following lot lines, such lot lines shall be construed to be such boundaries.
3. Where the boundary of a district follows a railroad line, such boundaries shall be deemed to be located at the railroad right-of-way line closest to the most restrictive zoning district line shown on the Zone District Map.
4. Where the boundary of a district follows a stream, said boundary line shall be construed to be the centerline of the stream, otherwise at the limit of the jurisdiction of the Village, unless otherwise indicated.
5. Any areas shown on the Zoning Map as park, playground, school, cemetery, water, street, or right-of-way, shall be subject to the zoning regulations of the district in which they are located.
6. Whenever any street, alley, or other public way is vacated in the manner authorized by law, the zoning district adjoining each side of such street, alley, or public way shall automatically extend to the center of such vacation and all area included in the vacation shall thereafter be subject to all regulations of the extended districts.
7. Where any land or territory within the Village is not shown to be located in a district, the zoning regulations of the most restrictive adjoining district shall govern.
8. Where a lot under single ownership is divided at the time of enactment of this Title, or by subsequent amendments, by a zoning district boundary line, the requirements of the less restrictive district adjacent to such line may be extended for that lot, not more than twenty five feet (25') into the more restrictive district.

C. Existing Special Uses. Where a use is classified as a special use under this Title, it shall be

considered a legal use, without further action of the Village Board.

**10-2-4: SCHEDULE: AREA AND BULK REGULATIONS; SIGNS; OFF-STREET PARKING REQUIREMENTS:**

A. To facilitate public understanding of this Title and the better administration and convenience of use thereof, the regulations limiting the dwelling unit density, the heights, bulk and arrangement of buildings, limiting the size and use of signs, and requiring minimum off street parking for each of the districts established by Section 10-2-1 hereof (or specified use), are set forth in Schedule 10-2-4 (E) hereof, hereinafter called Schedule. Such Schedule is hereby adopted and it may be amended in the same manner as any other part of this Title.

B. For each district (or specified use) named in said Schedule, the maximum number of dwelling units shall be as indicated in Column "(B)"; the minimum lot requirements shall be as indicated in Columns "(C)", "(D)", and "(E)" of the Schedule; the minimum yard dimensions shall be as indicated in Columns "(F)", "(G)", "(H)", "(I)", and "(J)"; maximum lot coverage therefore shall be indicated as Column "(K)"; permitted floor area ratio (ratio of floor area to lot area) shall be indicated in Column "(L)"; requirements for accessory buildings and uses, as to minimum distance of detached accessory buildings and uses to principal buildings, streets, and lot lines, as indicated in Columns "(M)", "(N)", "(O)", "(P)" and "(Q)", respectively; minimum off-street parking shall be indicated in Column "(R)"; other pertinent matters and requirements are as indicated in Column "(S)" and "(T)" and otherwise set forth in the Schedule and in notes and remarks appended thereto. (Amended Ord. 1558; 04/07/2015)"

C. A blank space in a block of a column of said Schedule indicates that the requirement of that column does not pertain to the district or use specified on the corresponding horizontal lines. The words "Same as SR-1 (or other symbol or reference)" as used in a column shall mean and include the specific limitations and requirements as set forth in the same column for a district referred to by such symbol or reference, otherwise the limitations and requirements in said Schedule shall be read from left to right.

D. Where the limitations and requirements of any Column "(R)" through "(T)" of the Schedule are contained in a block which, reading vertically on the Schedule, covers more than one district (or specified use), such limitations and requirements shall be applicable to all of the districts or used so covered by the block. Where reference is made in said Schedule to another Section or provision of this Title, such Section or provision referred to shall thereby be incorporated as an integral part of the requirement including such reference.

E. Schedule: Area and Bulk Regulations; Sign and Parking Requirements, See Schedule 10-2-4 (E).

**10-2-5: SCHEDULE: PERMITTED USES; ACCESSORY USES; EXCEPTIONS AND SPECIAL PERMITS:**

A. To facilitate public understanding of this Title and for better administration and convenience of use thereof, the regulations designating permitted uses, permitted accessory uses, exceptions and special permits for each of the districts established by Section 10-2-1, hereof, are set forth in Used

Schedule as Section 10-2-5, (D) hereof. Such Use Schedule is intended and declared to be an integral part of this Title and it may be amended in the same manner as any other part of this Title.

B. Each column refers to a specific district which list the permitted uses, permitted accessory uses, exceptions, special permits, and supplementary regulation references and are read vertically under a district column.

C. Limitations and requirements in the Use Schedule as used in a column shall mean and include the specific limitations and requirements as set forth in the same column for the district referred to. Where reference is made in the Use Schedule to another Section or provision referred to and shall thereby be incorporated as an integral part of the requirement including such reference. All provisions of this Title, shall apply as integral parts of this Section although not specifically cited in a column. See Section 10-2-5 (D).

D. Schedule: Permitted Uses, Accessory Uses; Exceptions and Special Permits. See Schedule 10-2-5 (D).

**10-2-6: FLOOD INSURANCE STUDY:** The Flood Insurance Study and amendments thereto, of the Village dated March 18, 1980, prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, is hereby adopted for the purpose of this Ordinance and filed in the office of the Village Clerk. The Flood Insurance Study includes a Flood Boundary and a Flood-way Map which delineates a zone as areas that are susceptible to the base flood, and delineates the Flood way, which is the channel of a river, or other watercourse and the adjacent land areas required to store and convey the flood water of the base flood with no significant increase in the height of the base flood. The Flood Insurance Study date shall take precedence over the Base Flood Elevation data for the purpose of this Ordinance.

A. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by the Village Clerk.

**SR-1 SINGLE FAMILY**  
**SINGLE FAMILY DWELLINGS**

**PERMITTED USES:**

Churches and other places of worship, subject to provisions of Section 3.06, but not including funeral chapels or mortuary chapels;

Electrical sub-stations (static transformer stations), gas regulation stations, telephone exchange facilities and essential services, subject to the provisions of Section 3.12;

Growing of plants and trees on a private or commercial basis, provided no retail sales are conducted on the premises subject to the applicable provisions of Section 3.17;

Municipal uses, facilities and buildings, subject to the provisions of Section 3.11;

Public, private or parochial schools offering courses of instruction at elementary or secondary levels in accordance with standards for compulsory education, subject to the provisions of Section 3.13;

Railroad right-of-way, not including switching, storage, freight yards, industrial sidings, or classification yards.

Nursery schools and orphanages subject to the provisions of Section 3.16.

**PERMITTED ACCESSORY USES:**

Private: greenhouses, tool sheds, garages or carports, tennis courts, patios, subject to the applicable provisions of Section 4.15;

Incinerators for home use, provided such are located on the lot so as not to constitute an unreasonable hazard to the dwellings and other buildings of the premises or on adjacent property and located not less than fifteen (15) feet from the dwelling on the premises and not less than ten (10) feet from any other building on the premises;

Keeping of household pets, provided kennels are not maintained;

Parking spaces not for gain in addition to minimum off-street parking, subject to the provisions of Section 3.04;

Keeping of not more than one unoccupied camp and/or utility trailer, subject to the provisions of Section 3.10;

Temporary construction sheds or temporary buildings for sale or rental offices or show houses for use during construction operations, provided all other regulations of the district are complied with, but in no case shall such office be continued beyond the duration of construction of the project or one year whichever is greater. However, such time limit may be extended for one year by the Board of Appeals;

Accommodations for professional servants, caretakers, watchmen or custodians, but not as a separate, detached one-family dwelling on the same lot;

Home occupations, subject to the provisions of Section 3.02;

Fences, hedges and walls, subject to the provisions of Section 3.01.

One storage shed not exceeding One Hundred Twenty (120) square feet shall be allowed on any residential lot containing a primary residential structure. Such shed shall not count against lot coverage regulations.

There shall be not more than two (2) such accessory buildings allowed on any residential lot in Single Family Residential districts only, as does not apply in Multi Family or Community Business districts.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

Electrical substations, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.10 and 3.12;

Gas regulator stations, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.16 and 3.12;

Other public utility distribution facilities, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.16 and 3.12.

**SPECIAL PERMITS:**

Community Residence, Class I  
Community Residence, Class II

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

All uses subject to the applicable provisions of Article IV.

**SR-2 SINGLE FAMILY  
SINGLE FAMILY DWELLINGS**

**PERMITTED USES:**

Any use permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district, except as otherwise provided in Section 2.04(e) Line 2.

**PERMITTED ACCESSORY USES:**

Any accessory use permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

Any exception permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district.

**SPECIAL PERMITS:**

Community Residence, Class I

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

All uses subject to the applicable provisions of Article IV.

## **SR-3 SINGLE FAMILY**

### **SINGLE FAMILY DWELLINGS**

#### **PERMITTED USES:**

Churches and other places of worship, subject to provisions of Section 3.06, but not including funeral chapels or mortuary chapels;

Electrical sub-stations (static transformer stations), gas regulation stations, telephone exchange facilities and essential services, subject to the provisions of Section 3.12;

Municipal uses, facilities and buildings, subject to the provisions of Section 3.11;

Nursery schools subject to the provisions of Section 3.16.

#### **PERMITTED ACCESSORY USES:**

Private: greenhouses, tool sheds, garages or carports, patios, subject to the applicable provisions of Section 4.15;

Keeping of household pets, provided kennels are not maintained;

Parking spaces not for gain in addition to minimum off-street parking, subject to the provisions of Section 3.04;

Keeping of not more than one unoccupied camp and/or utility trailer, subject to the provisions of Section 3.10;

Temporary construction sheds or temporary buildings for sale or rental offices or show houses for use during construction operations, provided all other regulations of the district are complied with, but in no case shall such office be continued beyond the duration of construction of the project or one year whichever is greater. However, such time limit may be extended for one year by the Board of Appeals;

Accommodations for professional servants, caretakers, watchmen or custodians, but not as a separate, detached one-family dwelling on the same lot;

Home occupations, subject to the provisions of Section 3.02;

Fences, hedges and walls, subject to the provisions of Section 3.01.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

Electrical substations, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.10 and 3.12;

Gas regulator stations, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.16 and 3.12;

Other public utility distribution facilities, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.16 and 3.12.

**SPECIAL PERMITS:**

Planned Unit Developments in accordance with Sections 5.06 and 5.11.

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

All uses subject to the applicable provisions of Article IV.

**TR-1 SINGLE FAMILY  
AND MANUFACTURED HOMES**

**PERMITTED USES:**

Any use permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district, except as otherwise provided in Section 2.04(e) Line 3;

Manufactured homes subject to the provisions of Section 3.09 2.

**PERMITTED ACCESSORY USES:**

Any accessory use permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

Any exception permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district.

**SPECIAL PERMITS:**

Community Residence, Class I

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

All uses subject to the applicable provisions of Article IV.

**MR-1 TWO OR THREE FAMILY**

**TWO AND THREE FAMILY DWELLINGS**

**PERMITTED USES:**

Any use permitted and as regulated in the SR-2 district, except as otherwise provided in Section 2.04(e) Line 4;

Two and three family dwellings.

**PERMITTED ACCESSORY USES:**

Any accessory use permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district.

Accommodations for one boarder or roomer.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

Any exception permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district.

**SPECIAL PERMITS:**

Community Residence, Class I  
Community Residence, Class II  
Community Residence, Class III

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

All uses subject to the applicable provisions of Article IV.

**MR-2 MULTI-FAMILY  
MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS**

**PERMITTED USES:**

Any use permitted and as regulated in the MR-1 district, except as otherwise provided in Section 2.04(e) Line 5;

Multi-family dwellings;

Boarding and rooming houses;

Dormitories or group living facilities for religious, educational or charitable purposes.

Nursing or retirement homes, subject to the provisions of 3.15.

**PERMITTED ACCESSORY USES:**

Any accessory use permitted and as regulated in the MR-1 district.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

Any exception permitted and as regulated in the SR-1 district.

**SPECIAL PERMITS:**

Community Residence, Class I

Community Residence, Class II

Community Residence, Class III

Community Residence, Class IV

Planned multi-family developments subject to the applicable provisions of Section 5.06 and 5.07.

Planned manufactured home parks subject to the application provisions of Section 5.06 and 5.08.

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

All uses subject to the application provisions of Article IV.

## B-1 COMMUNITY BUSINESS

### PERMITTED USES:

Any use permitted and as regulated in the MR-2 district, except as otherwise provided in Section 2.04(e) Line 6;

Places used for the retailing of those commodities which may be classified as “convenience goods”, “durable goods” and “fashion goods” as follows:

1. Apparel stores and shops;
2. Bakery shops, including the baking and processing of food products for products for retail sales on the premises only;
3. Candy and ice cream shops;
4. Commercial institutions such as banks, savings and loan associations;
5. Drug stores;
6. Eating and drinking establishments;
7. Food stores, including supermarkets, delicatessens, dairy products, meat markets, health foods;
8. Furniture, home furnishing and appliance stores;
9. Hardware stores and hobby shops;
10. Personal service shops, including barber and beauty shops, shoe repair shops, laundries, self-service laundries, dry-cleaning stores, travel agencies, photographers, tailoring shops;
11. Pet shops, but not including animal hospitals;

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**PERMITTED ACCESSORY USES:**

Service garage, only if in conjunction with and accessory and incidental to the sale of new or used automobiles; or the servicing of machinery, transportation vehicles or equipment directly related to the primary permitted use on the same zoning lot.

Storage of merchandise or inventory usually carried in stock; provided that such storage shall be located on the lot with the retail, service or commercial use and shall be within a completely enclosed building; or such storage shall be completely concealed by a fence at least six (6) feet in height.

Accommodations for caretakers, watchmen or custodians.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

Electrical substations, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.10 and 3.12.

Gas regulator stations, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.16 and 3.12.

Other public utility distribution facilities, subject to the provisions of Sections 4.16 and 3.12.

**SPECIAL PERMITS:**

Planned business centers subject to the applicable provisions of Sections 5.06 and 5.09.

Other planned building developments subject to the applicable provisions of Sections 5.06 and 5.10.

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

All uses subject to the applicable provisions of Article IV.
