## CHAPTER 3

## HOUSE NUMBERING

8-3-1: NUMBERING PLAN: All lots, buildings and structures in the Village shall be numbered in accordance with the following plan:

The base line for all streets running north and south shall be St. Louis Avenue; and for all streets running east and west the New York Central Railroad tracks. Even numbers shall be on the right and odd numbers on the left starting at each side of the respective bases. On all streets the numbering shall commence with the number one at each side of the respective bases and shall increase at the rate of one hundred numbers for each block. Twenty five feet ( $25^{\prime}$ ) shall be allowed for each number in the residential area and fifteen feet ( $15^{\prime}$ ) for each number in the business district.

8-3-2: CHART: The Zoning Commissioner shall keep a chart showing the proper street number of every lot in the Village which shall be open to inspection by anyone interested.

8-3-3: HOUSE NUMBERS AFFIXED TO HOUSE: The owners and occupants of every house in the Village shall have placed thereon, in a place visible from the street, figures at least two and one-half inches ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) high, showing the number of the house.

8-3-4: PENALTY: Any person failing to number any house, building or other structure occupied by him, or if after receiving notice to do so from the Zoning Commissioner shall continue in his failure to number such house, building or structure shall be fined one dollar ( $\$ 1.00$ ) for each day during or on which failure to so number continues. ( 1.963 Code, ${ }^{*} 8.02$ )
